
#### **Hospice Care**

- Holistic approach physical, emotional and spiritual care at the end of life
- Dedicated team of Physicians, Nurses, CNAs, Chaplains, Social Workers and Grief Support Counselors
- Focuses on Quality of Life
- Does NOT hasten or postpone death
- 24/7 support for patients and families
- Care provided wherever a patient calls home
- Covered by Medicare, Medicaid, many private insurances, or Charity Care



### **Inpatient Units**

- 3 units / 32 private rooms
- 24/7 acute pain and symptom management
- Short term stays
- Respite care
- Approximately **1,500** patients per year






