DID YOU KNOW?

Hospice often provides such comfort and support that many patients outlive their expected prognosis. Hospice care can begin when the patient's physician gives a prognosis of six months or less if the disease follows the expected course.

Hospice Care

- Holistic approach - physical, emotional and spiritual care at the end of life
- Dedicated team of Physicians, Nurses, CNAs, Chaplains, Social Workers and Grief Support Counselors
- Focuses on Quality of Life
- Does NOT hasten or postpone death
- 24/7 support for patients and families
- Care provided wherever a patient calls home
- Covered by Medicare, Medicaid, many private insurances, or Charity Care



Inpatient Units

- 3 units / 32 private rooms
- 24/7 acute pain and symptom management
- Short term stays
- Respite care
- Approximately 1,500 patients per year



Pediatric Care

- Little Treasures
 - Pediatric Hospice
 - PIC:TFK – Pediatric Palliative Care partnership with CMSN
- Focus on enhancing quality of life for children and their families
- Specialized team of Family Physician, Pediatric Nurse, Social Worker, Chaplain and Therapists

Treasured Pets



- Approximately 85 pets cared for annually
- Volunteer run - dedicated to caring for patient's pets
- Facilitate and Fund
 - Veterinary visits, procedures and surgeries
 - Grooming
 - Walking and play
 - Food and toys
 - Re-homing

Complementary Therapies

- Music, Massage and Aromatherapy
- Reduces pain, anxiety and depression
- Improves cognitive responses for patients with dementia
- Over **90%** of TCH patients report relief from negative symptoms after one session

As a board certified music therapist at Treasure Coast Hospice, Liz Lung has a highly-trained ear for creating pitch-perfect tones and listening to her clients' requests for the songs that resonate with them.

Courses in music, clinical, and music therapy foundations, as well as 1200 hours of clinical training, have prepared her with the strong foundation she needs to create a Plan of Care for each of those with whom she works.

"Progress or 'goals' look different for each patient based on their needs," said Lung. "These goals are then bro-

ken down into objectives that I work toward."
